

Assessment: Student Worksheet 5: The Perfect Video Checklist

- 1. Create a title slide to introduce your video with the name of your Vietnam veteran and the date of the interview.
- 2. Try to add some SOFT music in the background to help set the tone. Choose music that will not detract from what your interviewee is saying.
- 3. Embed photographs brought by your veteran or photos of mementos your veteran brought to the interview into the digital story.
- 4. Include a group statement of interpretation, identifying the most important information revealed by your interview and how interview affected you.
- 5. You must include documentation to lend credibility to your oral history. Consider any personal items the veteran showed you, stock photos of things like helicopters or tanks (example: stock photo of a CH-34 Army Helicopter and cite the website where you found it), and any military documentation regarding the war in Vietnam, and include those documents on this slide. Again, provide the date of the interview (example: Personal interview with ______ taken November 14, 2016, Anytown High School, Town, State)

Most importantly, YOU MUST VERIFY that your story is credible through the *documentation of any evidence* provided by your interviewee.
