Content: What does the source say? How does it say it?	
Creation: What is the creator or creators' point of view? How does this affect the content of the source?	
Quotes: Are there any notable quotes you want to return to?	
Circulation: Who came into contact with this source? What was the intended audience? How did they respond?	

<p>Connections: How does this source connect to other sources, events, people, etc.?</p>	
<p>Significance: What is the significance of the source? How did it shape its context?</p>	
<p>Corroboration: Where can you turn to verify the information in this source? What questions does this source spark, and how could you answer them?</p>
